Practical Knowledge for Everyday Protection

1 Home, Fire & Electrical Safety



Child alerts an adult to damaged wire. Always inform a trusted adult. Do not touch or try to fix electrical problems.

2 Food, Health & Hygiene



Wash hands with soap, drink safe water, eat clean food, and keep surroundings clean for good health.

3 First-Aid Awareness



Learn basic first-aid skills from trained professionals. Stay calm, assess, and seek expert help when needed.

4 Emergency Communication



Call trusted help like 112 or parent/guardian. Give exact location and stay on the line until help arrives.

5 Disaster & Climate Preparedness



Know your evacuation routes and assembly points. Be prepared for natural hazards and climate-related events.

6 Internet Safety & Cybersecurity



Use strong passwords, keep privacy settings on, and only talk to people you know. Report and get help.
